PPWR Compliance Statement

Dear customer,

We hereby confirm that our products and manufacturing processes for the packaging sector, as well as the packaging components used therein, comply with the applicable regulations and the currently applicable and verifiable requirements of **Regulation (EU) 2025/40** of the European Parliament and of the Council of December 19, 2024, on packaging and packaging waste (hereafter referred to as the 'PPWR').

The following information pertains to the packaging and packaging components that we, as a manufacturer, place on the market, as well as to all raw materials and auxiliary materials used, including adhesives, paints, varnishes, and coatings.

Our compliance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 is ensured based on our current knowledge and on the information provided to us by our suppliers.

The conformity assessment covers the following packaging components in particular:

- Cardboard boxes
- Wrapping and stretch films
- Paper bubble wrap
- Shipping labels
- Adhesive tapes
- Other packaging components used

1. Heavy metals (Art. 5, para. 4)

As a manufacturer, we ensure that the packaging and packaging components we place on the market comply with the applicable limit values for heavy metals (hexavalent chromium [Cr VI], mercury [Hg], cadmium [Cd], and lead [Pb]) specified in Regulation (EU) 2025/40. The sum of the concentrations of these heavy metals is below the specified limit value of 100 mg/kg.

2. PFAS (Art. 5 / para. 5)

No per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are intentionally added during the manufacturing of our packaging or its components, during further processing, or in connection with any raw or auxiliary materials used, including paper, adhesives, inks, paints, and coatings. Based on the information available to us, we confirm compliance with applicable PFAS limits.

3. Recyclability (Art. 6, para. 1)

Based on current knowledge, we consider the packaging and packaging components we place on the market to be recyclable.

As soon as the European Commission establishes criteria for recyclable design and performance levels for recyclability by January 1, 2028, as planned, we will conduct a corresponding reassessment.

4. Traceability (Art. 15, para. 5 and 6)

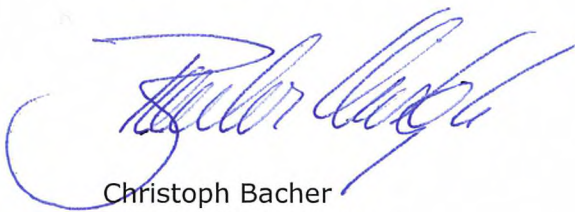
The manufacturer's identity and batch traceability within the supply chain are ensured.

This declaration refers exclusively to the currently applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

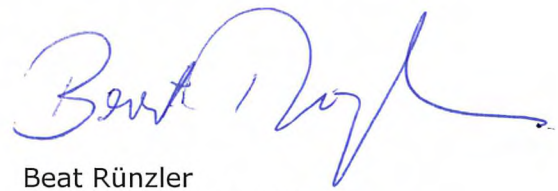
Should there be any changes to the regulatory requirements, we will adapt our processes accordingly to continue to ensure a **PPWR-compliant supply chain**.
